However, with new variants and subvariants circulating, and initial COVID-19 immunity waning, it is more important than ever to offer a COVID-19 bivalent booster. Coordinating immunization opportunities with community partners can lead to increased access to and acceptance of the vaccine.

Connect with Community Partners to Secure the COVID-19 Vaccine

- Work with state governments as they prepare to set up mobile and pop-up vaccination sites.
- Work with local health partners such as health centers, home health agencies, and pharmacies as they expand vaccine access through mobile and pop-up clinics as well as at-home vaccine administration.
- Work with community-based organizations as they expand vaccine efforts to include accessible vaccine clinics, provide in-home vaccinations, transportation and other supportive services.
