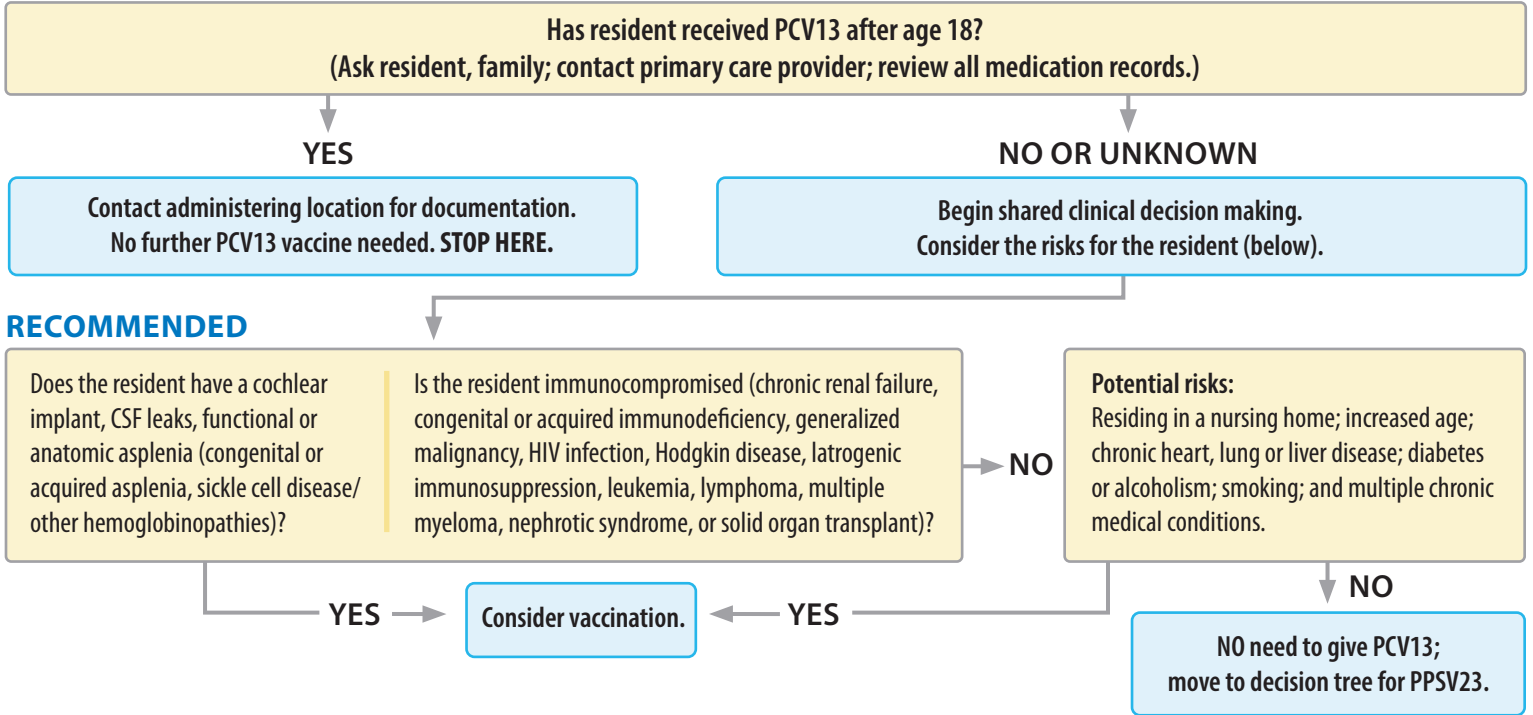




13-valent pneumococcal conjugate vaccine (PCV13, Prevnar 13®)



DECISION:

- Administer PCV 13 prior to PPSV 23
- Do **NOT** administer PCV13 because...
 - PPSV 23 has been given within the last year. You must wait a year for administration, follow-up date: _____
 - Resident does not meet requirement.
 - Resident was previously vaccinated.
 - Vaccine is contraindicated due to medical condition.
 - Resident refused.
